Keeping Western Australian Waters Oil and Pollutant Free, and Responding to Hydrocarbons in the Water

THE SPEAKER

Father of 2, Wayne lives in Scarborough WA. He is Royal Australian Navy Veteran of 10 years' service; served in the Iraq conflict 2002/2003/2007/2008 and multiple border protection operations with hostile engagements in both theatres. He has travelled extensively in operations all

over Australia, Asia, NZ, Vanuatu, Solomon Islands, Hawaii, the Middle East, and Russia. Spent last 15 years in Oil and Gas, working on offshore exploration operations, working in places such as the NW Shelf, Western Australia, Timor Sea, Darwin, Singapore, Egypt, Canary Islands, Mozambique.

Wayne will talk about the Department of Transport's responsibilities to the State as a Hazard Management Agency, how DoT approaches this responsibility and historical events and clean-ups in State Waters, and other Hazards that the Agency assists with.



Applications for RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards) for 2022 are open!

RYLA is an intensive eight-day program designed for 18-28 year olds with leadership potential and a commitment to community service. The program is a unique opportunity aimed to bring participants out of their comfort zone and challenge them to think outside the square while actively using and building on their existing skills and knowledge.

RYLA includes seminars, workshops, physical activities and team games relating to areas including Communication and Public Speaking, Leadership, Team Work and Group Dynamics, Problem Solving and Decision Making, Goal Setting, Time Management and Self Awareness and Emotional Intelligence.

Applicants are interviewed prior to acceptance onto RYLA. Successful applicants will have the energy, commitment and motivation to develop their leadership potential and be willing to challenge themselves physically and mentally over the course of the program.

RYLA is held at the Serpentine Camping Centre from Saturday 8th January - Saturday 15th January 2022.

Rotary Club Sponsorship for a RYLA participant is \$870, and the participant contribution is \$220. This includes all activities, accommodation and meals for the week.
