PRESIDENT'S REPORT FOR 04 JULY 2022

It was wonderful to welcome 26 members and guests to my inaugural meeting as President on Monday night. We were delighted to welcome AJ Joubert from Samaritans' Purse to tell us more about Operation Christmas Child, and it was fascinating to hear of this charity's achievements. Globally, an incredible 10.5 million shoeboxes were donated last year! About 27,000 were donated from WA, which were distributed through PNG. AJ showed some heart-warming videos of children receiving their gifts, which brought a tear to my eye, and I'm sure to several others as well! We were also shown how these boxes are distributed to far flung communities. Donations are rotated through communities once every 12 years, allowing for a wider spread of gifts. The WA target for this year is for 30,000 shoeboxes; so get planning and packing!

Nancy Bray who initially handled the Operation Christmas Child for Attadale Rotary for many years, was a welcomed guest, along with Jenny Calcei, Helen Carwardine, and Tania Solarzano.

Some high jinks followed, with Selwyn Castles winning the door prize, I won the draw for the Joker, but sadly not the prize! Our Happy Dollars elicited a number of laughs and Nancy Bray kept us very entertained with some of her very on-point comebacks!

There were a few issues with meals served on the evening and at the board meeting it was decided that we would complete our trial for the next two weeks before making any decisions regarding the venue. John will be liaising with Dome to get the issues sorted. Despite these hiccups, a really fun night seems to have been enjoyed by all.






